**Course Description:** Instruction in special situations and tactics. Stressful situations will challenge the student to perform under simulated field conditions. A specified firearms course will be required.

**Assessment:** Will be conduct before midterm.

**Target:** 90% of the class will pass proficiency in handling a handgun practical exercise with a 70% or better
